

Agreement between Humanities Tennessee
and the *Produce for Victory* Tennessee Tour Host Communities

THE EXHIBIT

SITES' traveling exhibitions may be used for educational purposes only. **No commercial or political use may be made of a SITES exhibition.**

The exhibition must be shown intact and in its entirety. No component may be omitted from an exhibition without prior permission from Humanities Tennessee.

The exhibition must be accessible to the public. Access shall not be denied to anyone on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, physical or cognitive disability, sex, age or any other basis prohibited by applicable law.

Smoking, eating, or drinking must be prohibited in the exhibition area and in the storage, receiving, and loading spaces at all times when the exhibition is within those spaces.

INSURANCE AND PROTECTION

SITES will provide wall-to-wall fine art insurance coverage, with standard exclusions, for the exhibition during both transit and display.

The Exhibitor will be responsible for a \$500.00 deductible for each occurrence of damage or loss during the term of the exhibition. The fine art insurance provided under this contract covers damage or loss incurred as a result of ordinary negligence, but the host community will be responsible for damage or loss caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct.

The Exhibitor agrees to notify Humanities Tennessee immediately of any theft, damage, or loss occurring while the exhibition is in its possession. The Exhibitor assumes responsibility for any liability that may arise because of the Exhibitor's failure to provide such timely notice.

The Exhibitor agrees to provide all fire precautions as required by law or local ordinance.
