

## **Yesterday's Tomorrows Letter of Agreement**

The Ohio Humanities Council (OHC) and the Center Of Science and Industry (COSI) agree to collaborate in presenting the Smithsonian Traveling Exhibition Service exhibit, *Yesterday's Tomorrows: Past Visions of the American Future*, for the community of Columbus, Ohio during the summer of 2003.

### **Specifically, the Ohio Humanities Council will:**

Obtain the *Yesterday's Tomorrow's* exhibit from the Smithsonian Institute Traveling Exhibition Service.

Provide transportation of the exhibit to COSI, arriving April 23, 2003, and leaving May 22, 2003.

Furnish an exhibition support manual, a Spanish translation of the exhibit script, and a teacher's guide.

Provide statewide publicity for the exhibit tour.

Provide a coordinator from its staff for program consultation and assistance.

Provide a program planning workshop in Columbus, September 12, 2002 and an installation workshop in Hamilton, Ohio March 17, 2003.

### **In consideration of the above, the Center Of Science and Industry will:**

Provide a secure exhibit space that is open and accessible to the public a minimum average of 25 hours per week.

Designate a Project Director who will cooperate with OHC staff in planning and conducting the exhibition in Columbus and will also attend a program planning workshop in Columbus September 12, 2002 and an installation workshop in Hamilton, Ohio March 17, 2003.

Pay a \$1,000 fee to the Ohio Humanities Council on or before March 17, 2003.

Provide personnel to install the exhibit and to dismantle and crate it for transport.

Maintain one or more persons to supervise visitation of the exhibit during all hours it is open to the public.

Report the condition of the exhibit upon its arrival and submit a closeout report to the Smithsonian Institute Traveling Exhibition Service.

Conduct local publicity for the exhibit.

**In general,**

The Smithsonian Institute Traveling Exhibition Service maintains “wall-to-wall” insurance coverage on the exhibit and no additional insurance is required.

COSI may conduct other programs and activities to accompany the exhibit and OHC encourages such.

COSI may apply to OHC’s grant program for support of programs accompanying the *Yesterday’s Tomorrows* exhibit, with OHC evaluating such requests through its normal procedures; no promise of grant support is made or implied.

COSI and the Ohio Humanities Council will mutually agree on local publicity materials.

**In referring to the Museum on Main Street presentation, *Yesterday’s Tomorrows* will always be credited as:**

The Ohio Humanities Council presents *Yesterday’s Tomorrows: Past Visions of the American Future*, an exhibition developed by the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service (SITES) with the National Museum of American History.
