

Guide to Spacing Museum on Main Street Exhibition Kiosks

Types of Kiosks for Museum on Main Street exhibitions and Square Foot Size
(all approximates)

Two wings	(5' 8 7/8" x 3' 2 3/8")	18.6 sq ft
Three wings	(5' 8 7/8" x 5' 8 7/8")	33 sq ft
No wings	(2' 4 3/8" x 2' 4 3/8")	5.4 sq ft

We recommend a minimum of three feet between each kiosk. Four feet is better, especially if you want to be in compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act. With this in mind you **will need more than:**

59 sq ft	for each two wing kiosk.
76.5 sq ft	for each three wing kiosk.
28.4 sq ft	for each kiosk with no wings.

The height of each kiosk varies. The tallest kiosk is 7' tall. In order to easily install and deinstall the exhibition **you will need at least a 7'6" ceiling.**

Other Information

- A Museum on Main Street exhibition requires at least 450 square feet for display. This measurement does **not** include space for supplementary exhibition or prop materials.
- Each top panel is approximately 38 x 27 inches.
- Each bottom panel is approximately 33 x 27 inches.
